A Person of Peace

“Whenever you enter a home, give it your blessing [of peace]. If it is worthy of the blessing, the blessing will stand; if not, the blessing will return to you.

“When you enter a village, don’t shift around from home to home, but stay in one place, eating and drinking without question whatever is set before you. And don’t hesitate to accept hospitality, for the workman is worthy of his wages!

“If a town welcomes you, follow these two rules:

(1) Eat whatever is set before you.

(2) Heal the sick; and as you heal them, say, ‘The Kingdom of God is very near you now.’

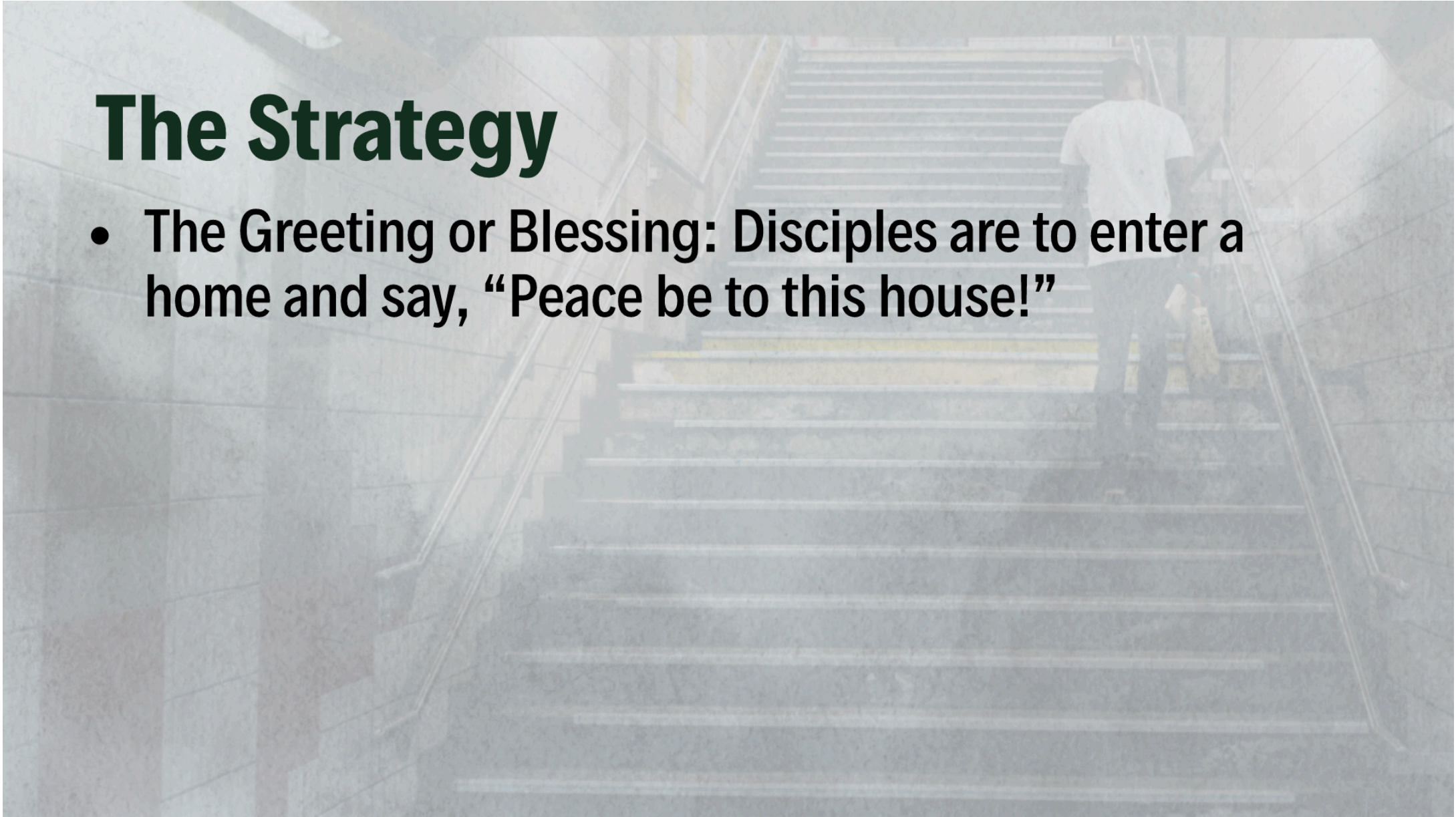

Key Characteristics of a Person of Peace

- **Receptivity:** They show immediate hospitality, welcoming messengers into their home to eat, drink, and stay.

- **Relational Influence:** They have a network of relationships, acting as a bridge to share whatever they learn with friends, family, and neighbours.

The Strategy

- The Greeting or Blessing: Disciples are to enter a home and say, “Peace be to this house!”

The Strategy

- **Discernment:** If a person of peace is present, the blessing of peace rests on them. If not, the peace returns to the disciples.
- **Stability:** The disciples are instructed to remain in that specific household, eating and drinking what is provided, rather than bouncing around from house to house.



Life-to-Life Transformation:

True Discipleship goes beyond a single conversation; it requires sharing life together (*event planners*), baptising, teaching them to follow your example as you follow Jesus and building relationships.

The B.L.E.S.S. principle

- B – Begin in Prayer
- L – Listen
- E – Eat
- S – Serve
- S – Story
